
#### **BACKGROUND**

- Road Safety Action Programme 2001-2010
  - White Paper on Transport (2001)
  - Objectives:
    - 50% reduction of road fatalities (from 54000 to 27000)
    - shared responsibility (Authorities, companies, users)
    - integrated approach (vehicle, driver, infrastructure)

#### THE RESULTS





#### WHY?

- Very general objectives
- Huge differences between countries (EU 15 / EU 27)
- No tailor-made plan
- No continuous monitoring
- Data collection needs to be refined



#### **NEW RSAP**

- Road Safety Action Programme 2011-2020
   Sets new priorities:
  - Vulnerable road users
  - Ageing population
  - Rural roads (> 50 % of fatalities)
  - Role of ITS

#### BUT

- No tailor-made plan
- No regular monitoring

- ...



#### THE 2008/96/EC DIRECTIVE

- Role of the Road Infrastructure
- Importance of the TERN
- Tools and procedures
  - RS impact assessments
  - RS Inspections
  - RS audits
  - Guidelines
  - Exchange of Best Practices
- Research and targeted investments



## **DEPLOYMENT (1)**

- Transposed in national legislation (19/11/2010)
- Applies to TERN & EU financed roads
- Other roads (MS provisions)
- Examples:
  - I, B (W/FL), F, LV, NL, P, E, S, RO
  - later translation (CZ, PL, EST)
  - BG?



# **DEPLOYMENT (2)**

- Countries with extended scope (other roads than TERN):
  - Mandatory (I by 2016 and 2021)
  - Voluntary (S)
- Only to TERN
  - E, P
- BG ?



#### CONCLUSIONS

Very effective and useful Directive

#### **BUT**

- Differences:
  - Countries
  - Scope
  - Timing
- Issues:
  - e.g. Independence of road auditors
